Michael Eck portrays Ken Gorman in the cast of RUMORS. A Hartford resident, Michael is a playwright, actor, and entrepreneur. He was last seen in Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat at the Warner Theater and starred on TV in I Married a Mobster on the ID Network and worked on many independent films, including a starring role in the feature film Holyland. **Caitlin Berra** plays *Officer Purdey* and has acted in countless productions at the Warner Theatre and TOH and worked with theatre crews backstage on theatrical lighting and set building. **John Fabiani,** seen in many TOH productions including The Full Monty, Miracle on 34<sup>th</sup> Street and 1776, completes the cast of RUMORS as *Officer Welch*.
